**Brief Job Description:** The primary role of the elderly caretaker is to assist elderly person in day to day activities such as ambulation, eating, dressing, toileting, grooming and in running errands .Assist in sanitation and housekeeping duties of elderly person's room and create and maintain hygienic and pleasant work environment.

**Personal Attributes:** This job requires the individual to be fit and energetic The person should be attentive, empathetic, dedicated and trust worthy. The person should possess effective and compassionate communication with client, family, and co- workers. The individual should have enthusiasm for the work they do and those in his/her care.

National Occupational Standards (NOS)	NOS are Occupational Standards which apply uniquely in the Indian context.
Qualifications Pack Code	Qualifications Pack Code is a unique reference code that identifies a qualifications pack.
Qualifications Pack(QP)	Qualifications Pack comprises the set of OS, together with the educational, training and other criteria required to perform a job role. A Qualifications Pack is assigned a unique qualification pack code.
Unit Code	Unit Code is a unique identifier for an Occupational Standard, which is denoted by an 'N'.
Unit Title	Unit Title gives a clear overall statement about what the incumbent should be able to do.
Description	Description gives a short summary of the unit content. This would be helpful to anyone searching on a database to find the required one.
Scope	Scope is the set of statements specifying the range of variables that an individual may have to deal with in carrying out the function which have a critical impact on the quality of required performance.
